What are my transportation/parking options for getting to and from the event?

Carpool, drop-off, and self-drive are all options. No SCL bus for this event. Directions from St. Louis : Travel south on I-55 to Exit 186/Imperial/Kimmswick. After exiting, turn right/west onto Imperial Main Street. Turn right onto West Outer 55 Road. Turning left onto Seckman Road will lead to the picnic area; turning left onto Museum Drive will take you to the museum entrance.
